### PAYMENT DATES FOR PLAN YEAR BEGINNING FEBRUARY 1, 2022

#### Direct Deposits

Direct deposit is a simple, fast, and secure way to receive payment of your benefit, and it's free. Your monthly benefit payments can be deposited directly into a bank, savings and loan, or credit union account. Direct deposit payments are normally posted to accounts no later than the first business day of each month, but the actual date you receive your payment will depend on the policy of your financial institution. If the first of the month falls on a weekend or holiday, direct deposit payments will usually post **the next business day following** the first of the month. Please note direct deposit is available only if your account is with a U.S. financial institution.

#### Paper Checks

The Central Pension Fund mails paper checks before the first of each month. However, the Central Pension Fund cannot guarantee actual delivery on the first of the month. Normal mail delays and delays due to inclement weather or other uncontrollable events may result in checks being delivered later than the first of the month. If you have a U.S. bank account, we encourage you to choose direct deposit.
